



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) *MoveIt! Walk Wilmington 2024*



When and where will the event take place?

Our Walk will be held on Saturday, May 18, 2024 from 8:30 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. at Long Leaf Park, 314 Pine Grove Dr., Wilmington, NC 28409.

How will the event work?

Our goal is to raise awareness of Parkinson's disease and to increase support for Parkinson Association of the Carolinas' (PAC's) programs and services offered to the Parkinson's community. We will be awarding prizes for Top Fundraiser, Team with the Most Walkers, and Team with the Most Spirit (matching team shirts, costumes, etc. – have fun with it). In addition, there will be an "Ask the Doc" session (you'll be able to ask questions to a Movement Disorder Specialist), a large number of disease specific exhibitors, a massage area, kid's activity area, "relaxation area," yoga, raffle prize drawing, live music and more!



Is there a registration fee?

It is free to take part in our MoveIt! Walk. However, we ask every walker to make a personal donation and/or commit to raising funds in the fight against Parkinson's disease.

Should I register to participate and/or fundraise in this event?

Yes! Register before April 12th, 2024 to guarantee your T-Shirt size. Anyone registered after April 12th may not receive their t-shirt size depending on availability. The funds raised from the MoveIt! Walk will help PAC to continue offering and expanding its movement therapy programs (exercise), educational events, other programming and Care Advisers for individuals affected by Parkinson's disease.



How do I register for this event?

Fill out the form, and you'll be set! Upon completion of the registration form, a personal web page will be added for you. **FEELING LUCKY?** Register early before March 17 (St. Patrick's Day) and you'll be entered into the drawing for a Fitbit!

How do I turn in my donations?

How do I set up a team?

Setting up a team is just as easy as registering as an individual walker. If you complete your registration online, you will select the option to "Set up a team." Upon completion of the registration form, your personal page will be set up, which you can edit as you wish; you can set your own goals for your team as well. Then, begin recruiting and find your team members!



What responsibilities does a team captain have?

Team captains are the heart of the Walk. As a team captain, you recruit your team of family, friends, coworkers, neighbors, etc., help them fundraise, keep them motivated, and have fun while raising awareness for Parkinson's disease. You will also have access to a team fundraising web page and numerous tools to make your team a success.

How can my company participate in or sponsor a walk?

Our MoveIt! Walk offers companies the opportunity to be leaders in their local community and in the fight against Parkinson's disease. You are not required to walk. Other activities and vendors will be available for visiting while the Walk is going on. Also, you are not required to walk the route a certain number of times. Walkers follow a route around the Symphony Park on the sidewalk which is not quite ¼ mile.
